- Most classes are eligible toward a two-year degree and are transferable to universities including Arizona State University, Northern Arizona University, and University of Arizona .

To be eligible:

- You must currently be enrolled in high school as a freshmen, sophomore or junior.
- Have a 2.0 GPA or higher.
- Have a valid Certificate of Indian Blood (CIB) or be an enrolled member of a federal/state recognized American Indian tribe.
