You may know that the Occupational Safety and Health program will be ending after Summer 2021. If you are just starting or close to finishing your Occupational Safety and Health certificate or degree, you have options both before and after Summer 2021.

YOUR OPTIONS:

- Complete GateWay OSH classes before or by Summer 2021
- Transfer your existing credits to a partner college or university offering a similar program
- Seek Credit by Evaluation for your prior learning
- Complete remaining classes at a partner college, and transfer credits back to complete your degree at GateWay
- Consider another certificate/degree option within Maricopa Community Colleges

Applied for one OSH scholarship within the last 24 months (demonstrated by submission of application and electronic confirmation application was submitted);

Attended two OSH professional association meetings within the last 24 months (demonstrated by attendance confirmation from the association and 400 word summary of the meeting with lessons learned);

Updated resume suitable for submitting to an OSH internship or full-time position (verified through GateWay Career Center with signature on business card of staff member and attached to resume);

Verifiable full or part-time OSH work experience (letter from employer or company business card) OR has met with GateWay college Career Center to select at least two internships or full-time positions for which he/she is qualified (verified through GateWay Career Center with signature on business card of staff member and attached to the two position postings); and

Selection of a OSH mentor within the safety profession with written outcomes (must be within the last 24 months and include a, minimum, 400 word overview of lessons learned).
