HEALTHCARE REGULATORY COMPLIANCE?

➤ **The Healthcare Regulatory Compliance Program (HRC)** provides education in the knowledge, behaviors and skills necessary to address the rapidly changing healthcare federal compliance regulations.

If you have current responsibility or would like to move into a position that is responsible for the oversight and management of healthcare services, this program will train you on how to interact with or even work for healthcare monitoring agencies that exist to enforce laws relating to fraud, overutilization of medical services, protected health information breaches and to investigate criminal behavior.

There are very few programs in the United States available to fulfill the educational needs of this rapidly expanding career area and many employers attempt to fulfill this need with limited on the job training.

➤ **Expect to:**

- Earn a Certificate of Completion in Healthcare Regulatory Compliance (16-19 credits).
- Prepare to oversee and manage health care services regulated by state and federal laws.
- Build foundational knowledge of numerous agencies enacting regulations, ethical aspects of regulations, design and development of compliance programs in various types of healthcare settings, all while working through real regulatory case studies in the industry.
- Gain the skills necessary to be an entry-level candidate for positions in various types of regulatory compliance and risk management settings.
- Progress through six HRC program classes at your own pace. The online classes are scheduled concurrently and in succession, based on your preference. HRC101 must be taken first before moving onto the other HRC courses.
- Be engaged in a recognized program in the health services field to be able to help employees and employers understand and comply with the growing number of state and federal healthcare regulations. Many students are funded by their employers to attend these courses.
- Attend courses fully online.
